





- The abstract shall not exceed 300 words, accompanied by a maximum of 5 keywords.
- It should be accompanied by a cover page including :

- v-** Contact Information - Email Address & Phone Numbers

Full Paper Submission

Upon selection of the Abstracts, the Author/s are hereby instructed to follow the guidelines as mentioned below for Full Paper Submission

- i-** Format of File - Microsoft Word
- ii-** Font - Times New Roman
- iii-** Font Size - 14 (Heading), 12 (Text), 10 (FootNotes)
- iv-** Margin - One Inch Margin on all sides
- v-** Alignment - Justified
- vi-** Line Spacing - 1.5 (Text), Single (Footnote)
- vii-** Citation Style - Bluebook 21st Edition
- viii-** Word Limit - 3000 -4500 words (excluding footnotes)
- ix-** Language - English Only

Any work generated by AI or that contains plagiarism will be immediately rejected. Only the cover page shall reveal the authors' identities.
