Sub: Extension of provisional approval of affiliation to VYDEHI INSTITUTE OF LAW for imparting 3 year LL.B., course with intake of 1 sections of 60 students till the academic year 2026-27 and 5 year B.A., LL.B., course with intake of 1 sections of 60 students till the academic year 2026-27 and 5 year B.B.A, LL.B., course with intake of 1 sections of 60 students till the academic year 2026-27 and 5 year B.Com LL.B., course with intake of 1 sections of 60 students till the academic year 2026-27 subject to compliance of Rules of Legal Education, 2008 and all circulars/directives/guidelines/ notifications issued from time to time by the Bar Council of India with respect to maintenance of standards of Legal Education in addition to the specific clauses mentioned herein under in this letter.

CLE to furnish a duly notarised compliance affidavit (Annexure – C/A) with adequate photo/documentary proof in this regard, with all pages of affidavit, annexures, photos, being duly notarised within 6 months from the date of receipt of this letter.

Sir/Ma'am,

This is with reference to above mentioned subject regarding extension of provisional approval of affiliation **VYDEHI INSTITUTE OF LAW** which has already applied for extension of approval of affiliation for the academic year 2026-27.

Your University has given affiliation to the VYDEHI INSTITUTE OF LAW for imparting the 3-year LL.B., and the 5-year B.A., LL.B., and the 5-year B.B.A, LL.B., and the 5-year B.Com LL.B., degree course for the relevant academic session.

In view of the same, Bar Council of India hereby grants extension of provisional approval of affiliation to VYDEHI INSTITUTE OF LAW for imparting the 3-year LL.B., degree course with intake of 1 section of 60

students and the 5-year B.A., LL.B., degree course with intake of 1 section of 60 students and the 5-year B.B.A, LL.B., degree course with intake of 1 section of 60 students and the 5-year B.Com LL.B., degree course with intake of 1 section of 60 students for a period of one year i.e. for the academic year subject to compliance of Rules of Legal Education, 2008 and all circulars/directives/guidelines/notifications issued from time to time by the Bar Council of India with respect to maintenance of standards of Legal Education in addition to the specific clauses mentioned herein under in this letter.

The entire onus shall lie upon the Centre of Legal Education to manifest its intention to continue the courses, to seek renewal of approval on an annual basis, and to ensure full, strict, and timely compliance with all provisions of the Rules of Legal Education, circulars, directions, inspection norms, and prescribed compliance affidavit formats issued by the Bar Council of India from time to time, and the Council shall not be under any obligation to presume or infer such intention in the absence of a complete and timely application. It is unequivocally clarified that any delay, default, omission, or non-compliance in payment of fees or guarantee amounts, in obtaining or submitting proof of university affiliation, or in filing compliance affidavits or other prescribed documents is attributable solely to the Centre of Legal Education, and the Bar Council of India has neither caused nor contributed to such delay nor waived any statutory requirement as a matter of course.

The provisional approval of affiliation shall be conditional and is subject to every Centre of Legal Education/college being required to submit a certified authenticated bank statement bearing bank stamp, date and signature, mandatorily with respect to the salary/ies being disbursed to all the teachers/faculties with effect from April, 2024. The bank statements for the upcoming months must be continued to be submitted every three months without fail, and CLE is also required to furnish list of teachers with qualifications as per BCI and UGC Rules, and further furnish proof/receipts of fulfillment of minimum library requirements, as enumerated under Schedule-III, Rule-15, Minimum Library requirements of Legal Education Rules-which is the sine qua non of a Centre of Legal Education. Certain show cause notices and compliance letters had also been issued specifically to certain Centers of Legal Education/Colleges, with conditions mentioned therein, which have to be complied too as per the time stipulations therein, and if they have not been complied with they must be complied with immediately.

This provisional approval is issued subject to strict and continuous compliance with the applicable statutory and regulatory framework and is without prejudice to the powers of the Bar Council of India to conduct inspections, impose conditions, refuse renewal, withdraw or cancel approval, or initiate regulatory or disciplinary action in accordance with law, notwithstanding the issuance of this provisional approval.

AFFIDAVIT

The Centre of Legal Education is required to ensure full compliance with all stipulated norms, rules, and regulations of legal education, along with mandatory guidelines issued by the Bar Council of India. This includes adherence to all enumerations specified in BCI
